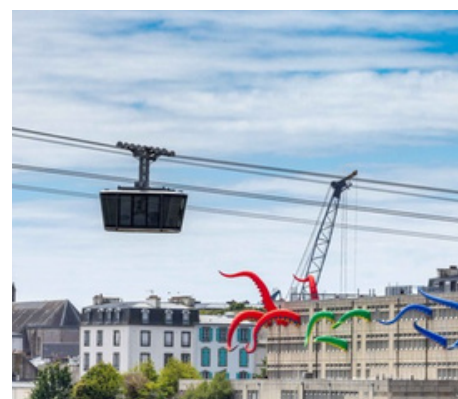

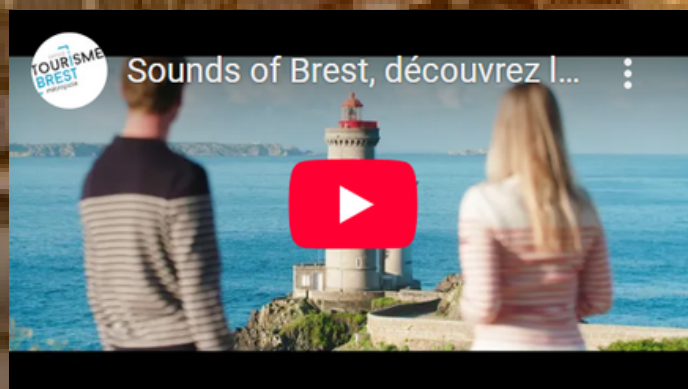
THE TIP OF BRITTANY IS SURPRISING

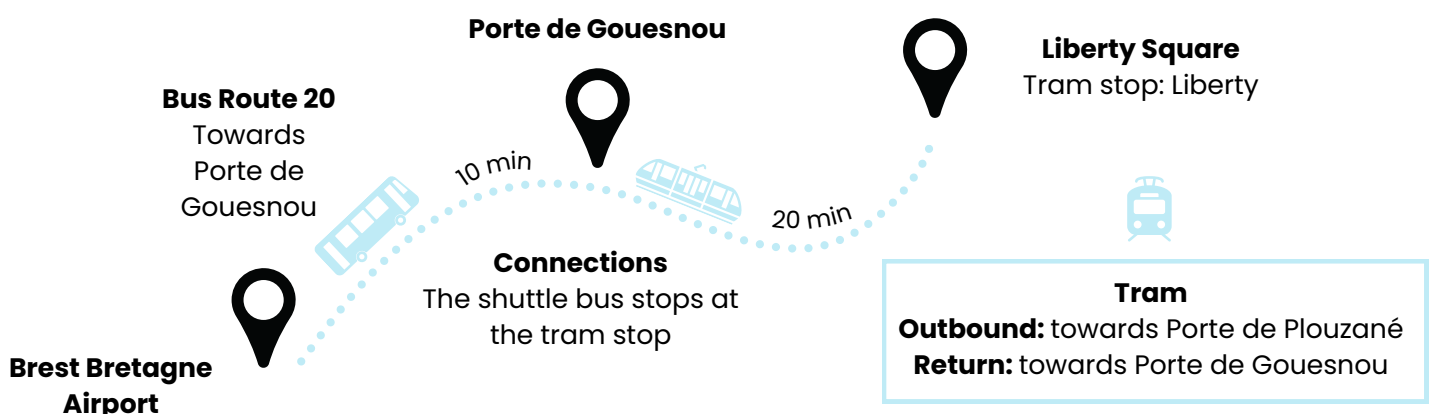

All the hotels, event venues and amenities in Brest city centre are within **walking distance**.



The city benefits from a **Bibus** public transport network covering the entire Brest area.



The Brest **cable car** connects the city centre to the Ateliers des Capucins, crossing the River Penfeld. As part of the Bibus network, it offers an eco-friendly mode of transport with stunning views of the harbour and the naval base.

Explore Brest at your leisure with the **VéloZef** bike-share stations, available in the city centre and across the city's neighbourhoods.

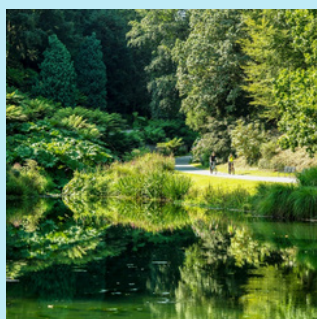
